

2010 REAL ESTATE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

2010 License Renewal Deadlines:

Brokers – 3/31/10

Salespersons – 5/31/10

You **DO NOT SUBMIT** Continuing Education Certificates with your 2010 renewal form or mail to this Department unless requested.

Please retain original certificates for 3 years in the event you are selected for audit by this Department.

2010 CONTINUING EDUCATION OPTIONS:

- A. Complete 12 Hours of Continuing Education courses from an approved school.
The courses shall consist of the following:
1. SIX hours (6) of Mandatory coursework as determined by the Connecticut Real Estate Commission. 2010 Mandatory courses are:

CONNECTICUT BUYER AGENCY (3 HOURS)

CONNECTICUT DISCLOSURE, RESPA AND LAW UPDATE (3 HOURS)

2. SIX hours (6) of real estate elective courses approved by the Commission and from an approved School.

- C. Brokers - If you passed your original licensing examination between 4/1/2008 and 3/31/2010, you do not need to take the continuing education courses for first renewal of 2010. **(The date used is not the issuance date of your first license, it is the exam date.)**

Salespersons – If you passed your original licensing examination between 6/1/2008 and 5/31/2010, you do not need to take the continuing education courses for first renewal of 2010. **(The date used is not the issuance date of your first license, it is the exam date.)**

Your Score Reports you received will reflect the examination passing date.
