

2012 REAL ESTATE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

2012 License Renewal Deadlines:

Brokers – 3/31/12

Salespersons – 5/31/12

You **DO NOT SUBMIT** Continuing Education Certificates with your 2012 renewal form or mail to this Department unless requested.

Please **retain original certificates for 3 years** in the event you are selected for audit by this Department.

2012 CONTINUING EDUCATION OPTIONS:

A. Complete 12 Hours of Continuing Education courses from an approved school.
The courses shall consist of the following:

1. THREE hours (3) of mandatory coursework as determined by the Connecticut Real Estate Commission. The 2012 Mandatory course is:

CONNECTICUT REAL ESTATE AGENTS FIDUCIARY DUTIES REVIEW AND LAW UPDATE (3 HOURS)

2. NINE hours (9) of elective courses approved by the CT Real Estate Commission and from an approved School.

C. Brokers - If you passed your original licensing examination between 4/1/2010 and 3/31/2012, you do not need to take the continuing education courses for first renewal of 2012. **(The date used is not the issuance date of your first license, it is the exam date.)**

Salespersons – If you passed your original licensing examination between 6/1/2010 and 5/31/2012, you do not need to take the continuing education courses for first renewal of 2012. **(The date used is not the issuance date of your first license, it is the exam date.)**

Your Score Reports you received will reflect the examination passing date.
